# SCHOOL OVERVIEW

Bethlehem College is a unique school, with a special character.

We are a co-educational, state-integrated (1/2 private & 1/2 public), Christian school, incorporating 3 schools in 1. Primary, Intermediate and Secondary. We enrol students from Years 1 – 13 (or 5 – 18 years of age). Bethlehem College has a roll of 1900+ students, including 85+ international students typically from countries including Brazil, China, Germany, Hong Kong, Japan, Vietnam, South Korea, Taiwan, Thailand and Chile.

We encourage students to strive for excellence in all things. We have clear, high expectations for the academic progress of each of our students, alongside a commitment to service, leadership, cultural and sporting endeavours.

# LOCATION

Bethlehem College is situated in the beautiful coastal city of Tauranga, approximately 2.5 hours south of Auckland. Tauranga has a mild, pleasant climate and is a top holiday and tourist destination, with the attraction of sun, surf and sand. Tauranga has a vibrant, multi-cultural community, with a fast growing population, now the 5th largest city in NZ.

# **FACILITIES**

Bethlehem Campus is situated on 140 acres of land, on the outskirts of the city. The Campus includes the College, a Kindergarten and a Tertiary Institute. From the moment you enter the school gates, there is a sense of peace and spaciousness, as you are surrounded by the beautifully landscaped grounds, multiple outdoor playing areas, and purpose built facilities. These include:

International students are placed with carefully selected, friendly, experienced host families. Homestays are chosen to meet the needs and interests of each individual student, providing a supportive environment to practice English and learn cultural diversity. Each family is visited, interviewed and monitored by our staff, and also vetted by the NZ Police.
